

Northside Church Student Ministry Summer Intern Application

Interns will be expected to meet certain qualifications and assist in many tasks. This paid position is open to students who have completed, at minimum, their first year of college. Interns will be expected to adhere to all Northside United Methodist Church policies. Interns will act in a supporting role for both the Student Ministry Director and the Metro Atlanta Project Director while exhibiting strong Christian morals and faith.

This internship is a paid position that will last from June 1 to July 25, 2025. Interns are expected to work 15 hours per week. The week of July 4th will have minimal hours; the week of Metro Atlanta Project (Monday, July 14 - Saturday, July 19) will have extended hours. Upon acceptance of the position, Northside Church will perform a background check and drug screening on all interns. Interns will also be required to complete Safe Sanctuary training.
